I am very excited to announce that Annie Hawksford, one of the ASB kindergarten teachers, will be returning this summer to serve as a KinderCamp instructor. Joining Annie this summer is Suzanna Olsen the other kindergarten teacher at ASB School. This is the first time in the history of ASB School that BOTH kindergarten teachers will be planning, teaching and leading the ASB KinderCamp program. We are very excited about the possibilities that this opens up for our program and the familiarity that this will allow our teachers and incoming kindergarten students. ASB School believes that children are competent, creative, and very capable and at Kinder Camp we will be exploring a variety of language, math, and science topics as well as developing social, emotional, and critical thinking skills needed for kindergarten.

Both Kinder Camp sessions are designed to work independently from one another, but also will maintain some continuity for those students that participate in both sessions.

Session One: Once Upon a Time...

We will read, tell, create, illustrate, and act out stories. Each day a new story sets the stage for fun activities and investigations that spark campers' curiosity and creativity. Experimenting with light and shadow, exploring nature, and dramatic play are integrated with children's literature, as well as with math, art, and drama.

Session Two: Construction Junction

Experiment with using various types of natural and man-made materials to create your own structures and inventions. How tall of a tower can you erect out of straws, or blocks, or cardboard boxes? How would you design and build your very own dream house? Language and art will be used in creating plans for construction. Physics and geometry will be explored as we use mathematical shapes and concepts to identify the science behind building.

Kinder Camp Information

1. Kinder Camp is open to students entering kindergarten at any school this fall and/or will be at least 5 years of age prior to attending Kinder Camp.
2. Kinder Camp begins **promptly** at 9:00 PM and ends at 1:00 PM.
3. Payment for Kinder Camp is due at time of registration.
Cost per session: \$150.00.
Discount: \$250 total if you sign up for both sessions.
4. If your Kinder Camper arrives prior to, or stays past, the scheduled 4 hour session (9:00 AM – 1:00 PM.), they will join the rest of Camp ASB and pay the rate of **\$7.50 per hour for ASB students and \$10.00 per hour for non-ASB students.** (You will need to complete the Camp ASB summer registration forms if you use our program beyond the Kinder Camp hours.)
5. If a session is canceled due to low enrollment, a full refund will be given.
Otherwise all fees are non-refundable.
6. **Deadline** for Kinder Camp registration is **June 1.**
